## Event Supplementary Regulations

### 1 Nature of Event

The event shall be known as Subareck Walky Wandering Wombat Rally' hereinafter referred to as 'the event'. The event will be a Special Stage Rally using A to B timing; and shall consist of an Intro rally (under NRC 1.34) and Rnd 3 of the Clubman and Hyundai Series and is open to members of all CAMS affiliated clubs.

### 2 Authority

- 2.1 The event will be conducted over public and private roads in the State of South Australia.
- 2.2 The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of FIA, the National Competition Rules (NCRs) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport (CAMS), the National Rally Code (NRC), the current SA Conditions of Rallies, the Event Supplementary Regulations and any Further Bulletins or Regulations as may be issued.

### 3 Running Details

- 3.1 Drivers briefing will be held at Walky Park in front of the shed at 13:30 hrs. All competitors must be present.
- 3.2 The event will start at Walky Park at 14:00 hrs on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2007.
- 3.3 Finish will be at Walky Park around 18:00 hrs for the Intro section and 20:45 hrs for Clubman section.
- 3.4 The route will be around 220 km in length with approximately 140 km of transport for clubman and 162 km in length with approximately 102 km of transport for Intro. All stages will be held on closed roads with gravel / dirt surfaces.
- 3.5 Timing for the Intro section will be to the whole minute, using target time, not elapsed time and the Clubman timed to the second. No reconnaissance is permitted.
- 3.6 The event is part of the Clubman Series and the Hyundai Series.
- 3.7 Fuel will be available prior to the start from the Truro United Service Station and Shell service station. Premium fuel is available from the shell service station, which closes at 8pm. "Plus ULP" 94 octane fuel is available from the United service station, which also closes at 8pm.
- 3.8 Manual refuelling may be performed at Walky Park in the refuel zone only.
- 3.9 In the event of *force majeure* the organisers reserve the right to abandon, postpone, cancel or shorten the event.
- 3.10 If there are less than 15 entries the organisers also reserve the right to abandon the event.

## 8 Judges of Fact

In accordance with NCR 181 the following officials are deemed to be Judges of Fact

- (i). Officials at events are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Direction of Entry at a Control
  - Dangerous entry in to Control
  - Time of arrival and departure from Control
  - Not wearing seat belt, helmet or safety clothing
  - Wrong direction on a Special Stage
  - Service Park infringements
  - Reconnaissance breaches including speeding, incorrect direction on stage and exceeding the number of passes over stage
  - Hitting or Missing Chicanes
- (ii). Scrutineers are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Vehicle in un-roadworthy condition
  - Vehicle with accident damage
  - Weight of a vehicle
  - Eligibility of Vehicles
  - Crew Apparel
- (iii). Medical Officers are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the Medical condition of any crew member or team member.
- (iv). Speed Monitoring Officials using suitable equipment are deemed to be Judges of Fact to the Speed of a competing vehicle, reconnaissance vehicle or service vehicle.
- (v). SA Police are deemed to be Judges of Fact on open public roads of the following:
  - Traffic infringement
  - Speed of a vehicle
  - Un-roadworthy vehicle

## 9 Entries & Start Order

- 9.1 The entry fee is \$250 for Clubman and \$180 for Intro, which includes organisational costs, CAMS Insurance, roadbook, road repair fund and trophy/promotions fund (Clubman only).
- 9.2 Cheques / money orders to be made out to Walkerville All Cars Club Inc. and sent to the Event Secretary with completed entry form.
- 9.3 Entries open 23<sup>rd</sup> August 0900hrs. **Entries close September 15<sup>th</sup> 2007 at 2000 hrs.**
- 9.4 Entries will be accepted from all vehicles complying with the general requirements for rally cars and the field will be limited to 40. If this limit is exceeded reserves will be allocated in order of receipt of entry.
- 9.5 Vehicles that are **turbocharged or supercharged** must be fitted with CAMS specification roll over protection. Intro category is restricted to 2WD or normally aspirated 4WD vehicles only
- 9.6 The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the NCR's.
- 9.7 Crews must consist of two persons only. Cars will start in competition number order, as seeded by the Clerk of Course, with Clubman entries first followed by Intro entries.
- 9.8 The driver and co-driver/navigator require a minimum of a Level 2NS licence for Intro and Clubman Rally Licence for Clubman. Other crew members are only covered for Personal Accident Insurance if they have a CAMS licence.

- 9.9 Intro entries are defined as those drivers who have previously competed in a maximum of three rallies, none at a state championship level, unless despite the driver's experience, the navigator has not previously navigated or co-driven in more than three rallies, none at state championship level.**
- 9.10 Clubman entries are defined as any driver or navigator who has competed previously in more than three rallies, or one or more state championship rallies.**
- 9.11 Entries for Intro will be accepted as one group, no classes.  
Entries for Clubman will be accepted for the following classes -
- Class P1 - PRC up to 1400cc
  - Class P2 - PRC over 1400cc, up to and including 1600cc
  - Class P3 - PRC over 1600cc, up to and including 2000cc
  - Class P4 - PRC 2WD over 2000cc
  - Class P5 - PRC 4WD over 2000cc (not meeting the requirements of Class P6)
  - Class P5S - PRC 4WD over 2000cc - Refer to Current SA Conditions of Rallying
  - Class P6 - PRC 4WD models first manufactured prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 1991 (and appearing on a list of 4WD cars, regardless of the date of manufacture, contained in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.)
- 9.12 The Clerk of Course reserves the right to amalgamate class awards should 3 or less entries be received for any particular class.

## 10 Maps and Instructions

- 10.1 Maps required for the event will be supplied by the organisers.
- 10.2 The Eudunda 1:100,000 topographic map may be of some use.  
Maps are available from Mapland, Level 1, 100 Pirie St, Adelaide.
- 10.3 Vehicles will require an odometer or some form of distance measuring device e.g. Terratrip, Brantz, Halda. A reasonably accurate odometer integrated with the speedometer will suffice.
- 10.4 The official odometer check in the 'City' is done by travelling east along Greenhill Rd between two marked power poles and is 5.64km long.

The Start pole is situated 100m West of Goodwood Rd. It has a sign stating "ODO Start" in white letters on a red background.

The End pole is situated east of Burke St (directly opposite Laurel Ave). It is marked "ODO Finish" in white letters on a red background.

## 11 General

- 11.1 Vehicles, to be eligible, must comply with the General Requirements for Rally Cars as well as the specific regulations relevant to the status of the event and must comply with CAMS Schedule A regarding minimum safety equipment.
- 11.2 Navigation aids and under body protection are free in all classes.
- 11.3 Disputes re entry in a particular class will be resolved at the discretion of the Clerk of Course.
- 11.4 Limitations on servicing will be advised in the route instructions. The maximum distance between services will be approx 100 km. Pump fuel is not available at the service area.
- 11.5 All crews must wear clothing that complies with the apparel regulations of Schedule D – Apparel, 3 (c) (iii) Social Stage & Non Special Stage Rallies. Helmets must be worn on closed road sections.

## 12 Scrutiny

- 12.1 Scrutiny for all entrants will be held at Povey Motors, 140a Tolley Rd, St Agnes between 19:00 hrs and 21:00 hrs on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> September.
- 12.2 Intro entrants entering in road cars may be scrutineered on the day at Walky Park from 11:30 hrs to 13:00 hrs on Saturday 22<sup>nd</sup> September. Re-scrutiny will also be performed during this time. Proof of passing scrutiny will be required before issue of route instructions.
- 12.3 Documents and items to be checked at Scrutiny will include;
- Civil licence for Drivers and other crew intending to drive
  - Current CAMS competition licence for driver and navigator (a minimum of a Level 2NS) \*
  - Current CAMS Affiliated club membership card for all crew members
  - CAMS Competition passbook or logbook if held
  - Vehicle Registration Papers
  - Reflective triangles, first aid kit, min 2kg fire extinguisher(s), mudflaps & driving lights if fitted. Helmets must be carried for all crew members.
  - Competition numbers will be supplied at scrutineering

\* Participants may purchase a CAMS Level 2NS license during scrutiny at a cost of \$48 Intro only.

## 13 Scoring & Timing

- 13.1 Refer to 3.5 for timing. The event will be using A to B timing.
- 13.2 Passage controls may be used to check compliance with the route instructions. It is the crew's responsibility to have the observations recorded on their control card. Failure to do so will result in the appropriate penalty, E.g. loss of 30 points for Intro and a 5 minute time penalty for clubman.
- 13.3 Crews are reminded that NRC 5.11 may apply during the event.
- 12.4 Penalties for hitting a chicane will result in a 10 point penalty for Intro and a 30 second penalty for Clubman entrants.

## 14 Protests

Competitors are reminded of the provisions of NCR 205 and Part XII re protests.

## 15 Crew Responsibility

- 15.1 Crews are advised that not all roads are closed for the event (except as specified) and all road rules apply. Speed checks may be undertaken.
- 15.2 The average speed for sections will not be set higher than 90 km/h. It is anticipated that most crews will clean most sections but not necessarily all of them.
