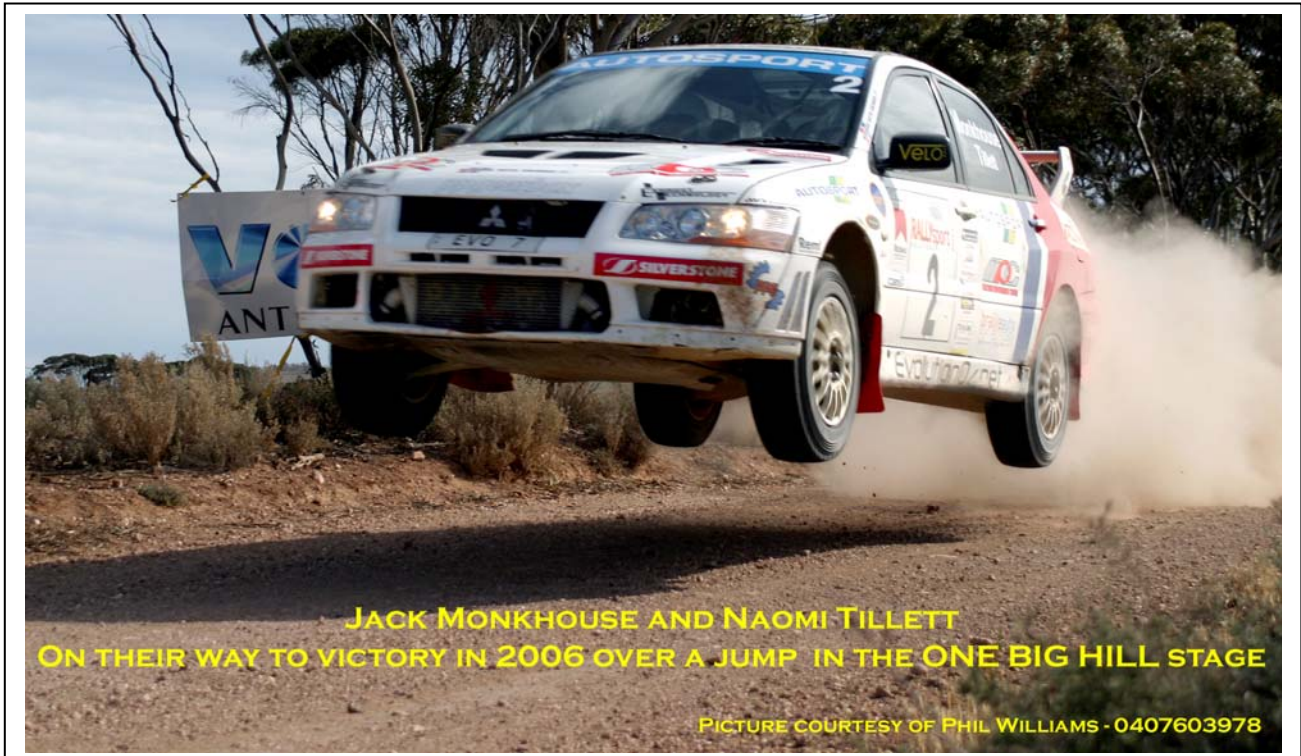

## 1.4 JUDGES OF FACT

*This regulation replaces and supersedes SARC Series Regulation 1.4.*

In accordance with NCR 181 the following officials are deemed to be Judges of Fact

- (i). Members of the Organising Committee/ Officials are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Direction of Entry at a Control
  - Dangerous entry in to Control
  - Time of arrival and departure from Control
  - Not wearing seat belt, helmet or safety clothing
  - Wrong direction on a Special Stage
  - Reconnaissance breaches including speeding, incorrect direction on stage and exceeding the number of passes over stage ( two ).
  - Conduct prejudicial to the interest of the sport.
  - Correct negotiation of man made chicanes
- (ii). Scrutineers are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Vehicle in un-roadworthy condition
  - Vehicle with accident damage
  - Weight of a vehicle
  - Not wearing seat belt, helmet or safety clothing
- (iii). Medical Officers are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the Medical condition of any Crew member.
- (iv). Speed Monitoring Officials using suitable equipment are deemed to be Judges of Fact to the Speed of a competing vehicle, reconnaissance vehicle or service vehicle.
- (v). SA Police are deemed to be Judges of Fact of the following:
  - Traffic infringement
  - Speed of a vehicle
  - Un-roadworthy vehicle

## Article 2. – SERIES ELIGIBILITY

## Article 3. - EVENT DETAILS

3.1 *This regulation replaces and supersedes SARC Series Regulation 3.1.*

The Robertstown Walky 100 (hereafter referred to as the Event) will be a Special Stage Rally using A to A timing, as per National Rally Code 1.33, held under the International Sporting Code of the FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS, the current Conditions of Rallying for South Australia, the SARC Series Regulations, these Event Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations or Bulletins that may be issued.

3.2 The CAMS Permit Number authorising the event is 507/3006/01

3.3 The length of the rally will be approximately 286km, including 8 Stages which have a total competitive distance of approximately 121km. All special stages are of a gravel/dirt surface, held in the Robertstown environs on a combination of private property and (closed) public roads.

3.4 The Event will consist of one Heat on one day.

6.2 Entries open 0900 hrs on Friday 1st June 2007.

6.3 Standard Entries close 2000 hrs on Friday 8th June.

6.4 Final Entries close 2000 hrs on Friday 15th June.

6.5 Drivers without a current DPI listing will be seeded at the discretion of the Clerk of Course. Entrants who feel they have reason to be seeded in a particular way are encouraged to detail such reason(s) in writing before the close of entries.

6.6 *This regulation replaces and supersedes SARC Series Regulation 6.6.*

The number of entries will be limited to 40. If this limit is exceeded preference will be given to drivers who have registered for the current South Australian Rally Championship and then in **order of receipt of a fully completed entry form and payment in full**. The organisers may establish a waiting list.

6.7 The entry fee for the Event is fixed as follows:

6.8 Extra road books may be purchased for \$25 prior to the close of entries. The number of additional road books is to be specified on the entry form.



## IV. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINY

### Article 10. - DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINY

- 10.1 Documentation will be available during the following times and must be completed prior to presentation of that vehicle for scrutiny –  
**Thursday June 28th, 1830hrs to 2030 at Rising Sun Car Service,  
566 Main North Road  
Gepps Cross.**
- 10.2 Vehicles must be presented for scrutiny on **Thursday June 28th** between 1900 hrs (1830 hrs for turbo sealing) and 2200 hrs (unless granted an exemption which needs to be applied for in writing to the Clerk of Course 1 week before scrutiny) at: **Rising Sun Car Service.** Failure to comply with these requirements will result in a time penalty being imposed at the discretion of the Stewards of the Meeting.
- 10.3 Vehicles requiring re-scrutiny, or those vehicles granted an exemption from Article 10.2 are required to attend scrutiny at **Keller Fuels** between **0900 hrs** and **1000 hrs** on Saturday 30th June.
- 10.4 Turbo Scrutiny will be held for all vehicles fitted with a turbocharger on **Thursday June 28th** from 1830 hrs until 2030 hrs at the scrutiny venue, listed in 10.2. Vehicles granted exemption from Article 10.2 will be scrutineered as per Article 10.3
- 10.13 Parc fermé will be located at the **Robertstown Oval**, where all vehicles will be held until post event scrutiny has been completed or the Stewards allow them to be removed. Refer to Article 10.12 of the Series Regulations for early removal.

## V. RUNNING OF THE RALLY

### Article 11. - START

- 11.1 Both driver and co-driver **MUST** be present at Competitors' briefing at **1100** hrs on Saturday 30th June at the Rally Head Quarters. Non attendance will be reported to the Stewards and the recommended penalty will be exclusion.
- 11.2 The Rally will start at **1200** hrs on Saturday 30th June and the first car will finish at approx **2000** hrs at the **Robertstown Oval**.
- 11.3 Competing Vehicles are required to be placed in the Staging area before 1045 hrs. The location of the staging area shall be defined in the road book.
- 11.4 During the rally, the natural lighting conditions will not be the same for all competition crews on all stages. This will be most evident on stage 7.

## VI. AWARDS

### Article 15. PRIZES, TROPHIES AND AWARDS

15.1 The Trophy Presentations will be held at Rally HQ on the day of the event from 2130 hrs to 2230 hrs. Refer to Series Regulations for Outright and Class awards to be presented.

#### 15.2 McLeod Medal Award

In honour of Stewart McLeod, six times winner of the South Australian Rally Championship.

Eligibility: driver or co-driver must be a bona fide resident of South Australia and a current financial member of a South Australian club; or be a member of BSCC. Competitors must be in their first calendar year of rallying at State Championship level and must not have competed at that level anywhere else.

#### 15.3 Lincoln Harding Memorial Award

Encourages drivers to continue to develop and improve their skills.

Eligibility: All drivers named in the "Drivers Performance Index (DPI) as in the current Conditions for Rallies in South Australia.

#### 15.4 Revolution Racegear Team Award

The Revolution Racegear Team Award will be presented to the team of competitors with the lowest combined handicap score for the event. The award will consist of trophies for each member of the team and a \$50 Revolution Racegear voucher.

The combined handicap score will be calculated by adding the handicap scores for each of the crews in the team and dividing by the number of crews in that team. The handicap score shall be calculated in accordance with the 2007 Conditions for Rallies.

Teams shall consist of three competing vehicles and/or crews, except if the number of entries is not divisible evenly by three, in which case the Clerk of Course will allow one team consisting of either four, or five vehicles/crews, as appropriate, if necessary. Competing teams must be nominated on the entry form before 2100 hrs, Friday June 15. The Organisers may group any vehicles/crews not so nominated into one or more teams prior to the start of the event.

Crews may be members of one team only for the purposes of the Revolution Racegear Team Award.

To be eligible for the Revolution Racegear Team Award, all cars in that team must be classified as "finishers" in the event.

To receive Teams Award prizes, prize-money or trophies, a representative from the winning team must attend the presentation function to receive the award. In the event that no such representative is present, the award will be forfeited.

#### 15.5 Walky 500 Trophy

The "Walky 500 Trophy" shall be presented to the highest placed crew who are financial members of the Walkerville All Cars Club Inc.
