1. Nature of Event

The event shall be known as the '2001 Robertstown Rally', hereafter referred to as 'the event' and shall be a Multi Club Rally.

The event is a competitive event, designed to test the skill of the driver and co-driver and the reliability and mechanical condition of the competing vehicle.

2. Authority

The events will be conducted over closed public and private roads in the state of South Australia. The event will be held under the International Sporting Code of FIA, the National Competition Rules of CAMS Limited (NCR's), the National Rally Code (NRC), 2001 Conditions for Rallies in South Australia, the Autosport Cup Standing Regulations, the Event Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations as may be issued.

3. Running Details

The event will start and finish at the Robertstown Football Oval.

There will be 10 competitive sections totaling 61 kilometres. Total event distance will be 216 kilometres.

Fuel will be available from Robertstown Shell.

Servicing will be conducted centrally from Robertstown Oval. The maximum distance between service points will be 24 kms competitive / 67 kms total.
