- Sighting Lap 10:00 AM
- Event Start (Following Sighting Lap)
- Last Run will be determined on the day based on dust and light levels
No runs will be done after dark – lights will not be required.

- **Competitor Briefing 07: 30 AM**
- Sighting Lap 07:45 AM
- Event Start (Following Sighting Lap)
- Last Run to commence before 03:00

Note - A 45-minute lunch break for officials will be taken on both Saturday and Sunday at a convenient time between runs while track layouts are being changed.

4 . Event Length

4.1 – Most tracks at Walky Park are between 1.5km and 2km

4.2 – The planned minimum number of runs for the weekend will be 20

4.3 – The Maximum number of runs for the weekend will be 28

4.4 – The Event Organisers reserves the right that the event may be abandoned, postponed, stopped or shortened in accordance with section 13 of the series regulations.

- Doing your own thing


7.4 – **This is a CASH FREE EVENT** – We have multiple other payment options available including EFTPOS but we will not be accepting CASH on the day.

8.1 – Camping at the Venue is encouraged, and the venue will be open from Friday night until Monday morning.

8.2 – There are 24/7 toilet facilities, but no showers. There is no electricity available once the generator is turned off.

12 . Series Regulations

12.1 – Please read the supplementary regulations for this event in conjunction with the [2023 Walky Park Khanacross Series Regulations](#). The event will be run as per the series regulation except for any specific amendments as specified in these supplementary regulations.

12.2 – Passengers may be carried on all runs, but competitors are reminded that carrying passengers excludes you from receiving points in the SA Khanacross Championship.

13 . Warm-Up / Test Road

13.1 – The Warm-Up / Test Road will be available, competitors can use this to get the vehicle up to temperature and to perform mechanical and safety checks to ensure that everything on the vehicle is working correctly if needed.

13.2 – This road is one way, has a max speed of 40Kph and is a no wheel spin zone for its full length. Upon reaching the end competitors are to use the main driveway to return to pits at signposted speeds.
