

11 . Warm-Up / Test Road

11.1 – A New Warm-Up / Test Road has been set up. Competitors can use this to get the vehicle up to temperature and to perform mechanical and safety checks to ensure that everything on the vehicle is working correctly if needed.

11.2 – This road is one way, has a max speed of 40Kph and is a no wheel spin zone for its full length. Upon reaching the end competitors are to use the main driveway to return to pits at signposted speeds.
