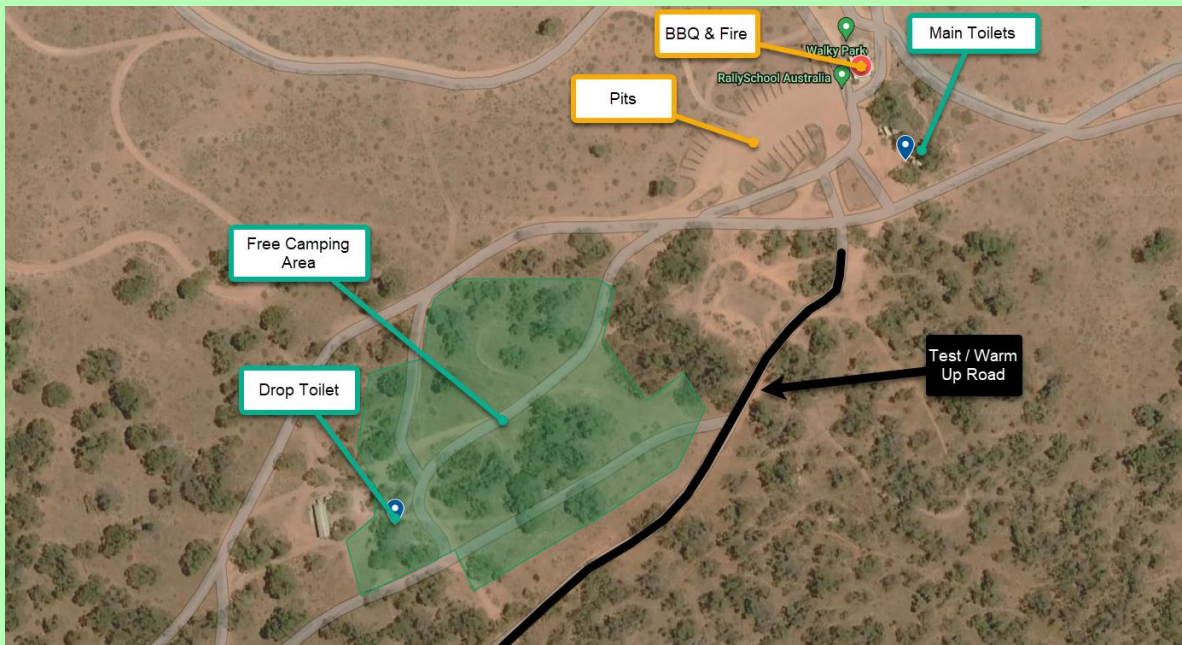
7.3 – **This Round does not have a Khanacross or RallySkills component, therefore Competitors have been advised that Section 5 and Section 6 will not apply to this event.**
