PASPREM

This is our Holden HK Premier, in original-spec factory colour (Silver Mink). This was purchased by my grandfather (Pa) brand-new in 1968 from Watson's of Greenborough, a Holden dealership in Melbourne (trading an EH Holden), and used as a daily driver until 2001 when Pa couldn't drive anymore. It was built in Dandenong, Melbourne, and was originally spec'd with 186 and 2-speed PowerGlide transmission. The interior is light-teal combination fabric with vinyl outers. It also came with upgraded dash (from warning lights to gauges) and AM radio from the factory. Later on it was fitted with a Hayman Reece towbar (rated to 4500kg according to the plate!), and also a 3-speed Trimatic transmission, and it towed the caravan for half of its life. In 2001, my father and I drove it down from Hervey Bay in QLD down to SA (I was on my L-plates!) and it ticked over 100000 miles as we drove it into the garage.





There it sat until April 2023 when I proposed to my then girlfriend and discussed having the car in the wedding which was 15 months away. At that stage it was very ratty! A Poor re-spray in the 90s was all peeling and there was a bit of rust and bog exposed in places from when Nan jack-knifed the caravan! So the major restoration was started! We stripped most of the componentry ourselves, with the motor going to JH Southcott and the body of the car going to OB Restorations in Encounter Bay. We completely removed the front sub-frame and stripped it back to the firewall, cleaning the engine bay from all the "extras", and lowered the suspension slightly to wrap around the jelly-bean alloys we had restored for it. I fully re-wired it in the shed at home, upgrading some of the terrible plastic connectors and moving all the wiring out of sight. Apart from the driver's seat, which had collapsed on the side, the interior wasn't touched at all – when new, Nan & Pa had fitted seat covers and clear plastic floor mats. When we removed these it was all immaculate underneath! Dad was an ex-Holden mechanic, so he "upgraded" some of the engine components (bored out 60-thou, and I'm pretty sure triple-SU carbies weren't standard \mathfrak{S})

Of course, the 2 weeks leading up to the wedding were in the shed until midnight every night doing final assembly. Then on wedding-eve it was running, and all looking good for the big day! Unfortunately, on the morning of the wedding, the carbies all started leaking fuel onto the exhaust manifold and we didn't have time to investigate or repair, so we had to switch to plan-B. But a great friend of mine (shout-out to Rob Seymour!) loaded it onto a car trailer for us, and proceeded to follow us everywhere, unloading and positioned it for our photos as it would have been. It was incredibly special to have it present on the day.

In our family, I knew my grandfather as Pa, and my kids know their grandfather (my Dad) as Pa, so "PA'S PREM" it is! I look forward to hopefully making it to 83 years-old and handing the keys to my grandkids. "This car is 100 years old. You can't buy fuel for it anymore, but it's pretty cool!!"





RALLY SKILLS PROGRAM - 2025

Goals of Rally Skills Program

The Rally Skills Program's goals are to provide a safe space for young people and adults to learn and develop skills driving on gravel, with an emphasis on providing a gateway into Motorsport.

By developing a driver education program, we aim to educate drivers on the skills required to drive on gravel, as well as learn general driving skills. We will provide students an outlet to learn in a safe environment, being taught by experienced instructors in a family-friendly environment.

Students will use a supplied vehicle during the Program, to get experience and decide if they would like to pursue the sport, before having to outlay equipment and a vehicle, which can be a barrier to people participating.

The program aims to provide on ongoing support to assist students of the program to continue to develop skills and further their careers. We hope to start a buddy system where a participant can continue to be mentored by another club member to help them increase their skills and continue into the next level of Motorsport.

The program consists of 3 full day sessions/lessons with final event day when students get the opportunity to compete in a Walkerville All Cars Club Khanacross. The program will run once per year. A maximum of 12 students, split into two groups of 6.



RALLY SKILLS PROGRAM - 2025

Goals of Rally Skills Program

Day 1 of the program - 5th April

Please arrive by 9:00am as we will need to complete some paperwork, and everyone needs to sign on to be covered by insurance. There will be a drivers' briefing at 9:30. This is compulsory for both students and trainers/officials. Safety is paramount and the first sessions will cover car and personal safety, allocate students to their groups, how to put on a helmet, correct seating position and scrutineering of the RSP cars. After lunch, we will start working on cornering, weight transfer and stop/start, both theory and in car. Cars will be provided by RSP.

Day 2 of the program - 28th June

Activities will include cornering/gear changes, left foot braking, rally rules, Co-driver duties, pace notes, tyre technology and how to change a tyre safely.

Day 3 of the program - 27th September

Activities will include reinforcing day 1 & 2 skills, dummy Khanacross track, Event entry via Motorsport Australia (MA) portal, cost of building a Khanacross car, loading and towing a car trailer safely, Fire safety including extinguishing a fire.

Day 4 of the program - 26th October

You will participate in a timed Khanacross competition. Using your knowledge from day 3, you will be responsible to enter the event via the MA portal (we will assist if you have any problems). If you have your own car, you may use it for day 4 provided it passes scrutineering on the day, other wise a RSP car will be allocated to you.


