1. Authority

1.1 – The Event, hereafter referred to as "the event", will be a round of the SA Autocross Championship and include both Autocross and Rallysprint Category's.

1.2 – The Promoter of the event is Walkerville All Cars Club

1.3 – The event will be conducted under:

- The International Sporting Code of the FIA;
- The National Competition Rules of Motorsport Australia;
- The Speed and Non-Speed Event Standing Regulations;
- The Motorsport Australia Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy and the Motorsport Australia Come and Try Policy;
- The Walky Park Series Regulations as available on the WACC Facebook, Website and Sportity App (Virtual Noticeboard)
- These Supplementary Regulations and any further Supplementary Regulations or Bulletins which may be issued.
- This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with Motorsport Australia OH&S, Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies and in accordance with any of the current Motorsport Australia COVID-19 Ready to Race strategy requirements, which can be found on the Motorsport Australia website at www.motorsport.org.au.

5 . Series Regulations

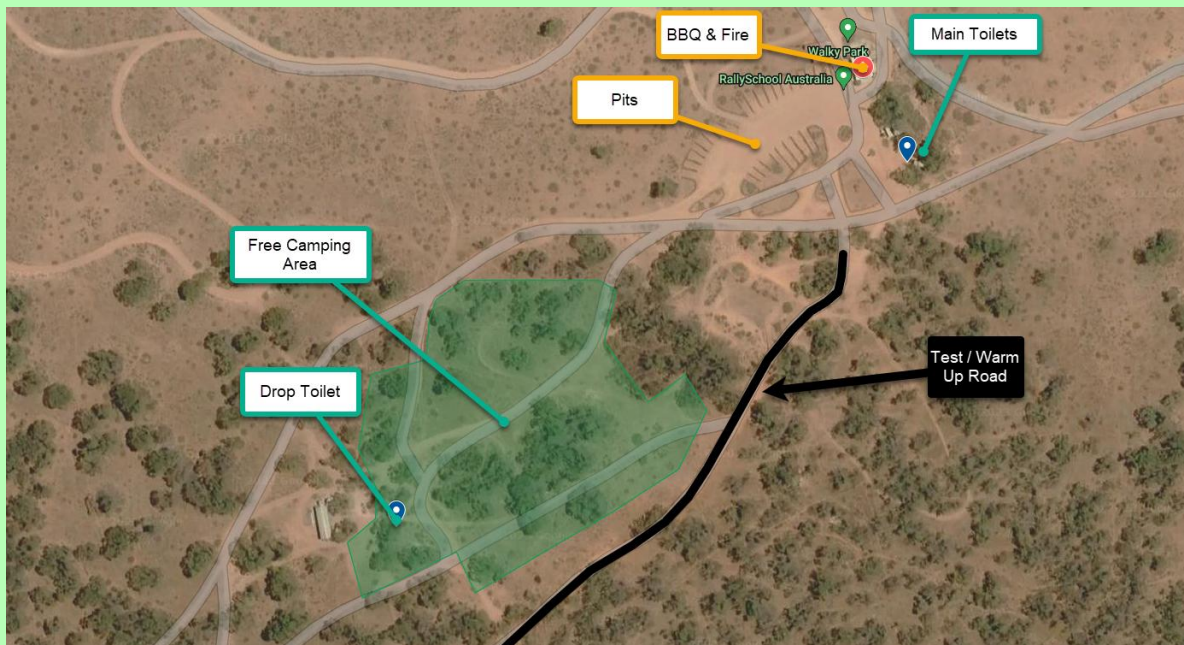
5.1 – Please read the relevant sections of the [2026 Walky Park Series Regulations](#) in conjunction with these supplementary regulations.

6 . Camping

6.1 – Camping at the Venue is encouraged, and the venue will be open from Friday night until Monday morning.

6.2 – There are 24/7 toilet facilities, but no showers. There is no electricity available once the generator is turned off.

7 . Entry Details - Price

7.1 Entries for this event will open upon the publication of the event on the Motorsport Australia portal.

7.2 Entries will close at midnight on Wednesday, the 5th of August.

7.3 Late entries will be accepted until 10 PM Friday, the 7th, but late entries will not be eligible for SA series points.

7.4 – Entry Fees for this event will be as follows:

- \$165 - Adults SA Autocross Series (No Passengers and Series Points Awarded)
- \$150 - Club Rallysprint (Passengers and No Series Points)
- \$110 - Juniors Under 18 Autocross Series
- \$95 - Juniors Under 18 Club Rallysprint
- \$150 - RSP Additional Practice / Instruction Day

7.5 – Entry will be via the Motorsport Australia Event Portal.

8 . Club Series and Championship Points.

8.3 – Competitors who enter and wish to receive points in the SA Autocross Championship will not be allowed to carry passengers. All other competitors may carry passengers.

8.4 – Competitors who wish to receive points in the championship will be required to indicate that on the entry form; competitors who fail to select that option will not be eligible for points in the SA Autocross Championship.

9 . Sportity

9.1 – All event documentation and forms will be available on the event virtual notice board - Sportity APP and website; this will be the primary source of information pre-event, post-event and throughout and will be used at all events this season.
