Statement re Fuel Crisis

After a long and agonizing couple of weeks, the committee of Walkerville All Cars Club Inc. has decided that the only practical decision is to postpone day 1 of the Rally skills Program (RSP) on Saturday 18 April and the Rally Sprint on Sunday 19 April. This decision has not been made lightly. The committee took into consideration the cost and availability of fuel for both competitors and officials. They also considered the possible negative public perception of running an event while farmers, the transport industry and essential services are having problems in procuring enough fuel. As soon as the situation in Gulf clarifies, we will advise further.

New dates are shown in updated calendar as RSP moving to 16/05 and the Rally Sprint to 08/11. We all hope normality returns sooner rather than later and further postponements or cancellations will be unnecessary.

There has also been a date change for the Gorge Rally Sprint. This is for unrelated reasons.

I guess an upside to postponing the coming RSP/ Rallysprint dates means we have so much longer to save our pennies for entry fees etc. This might mean we have better cash flow right now and may be able to better support our Biggest Morning Tea, Cancer Council Supper.

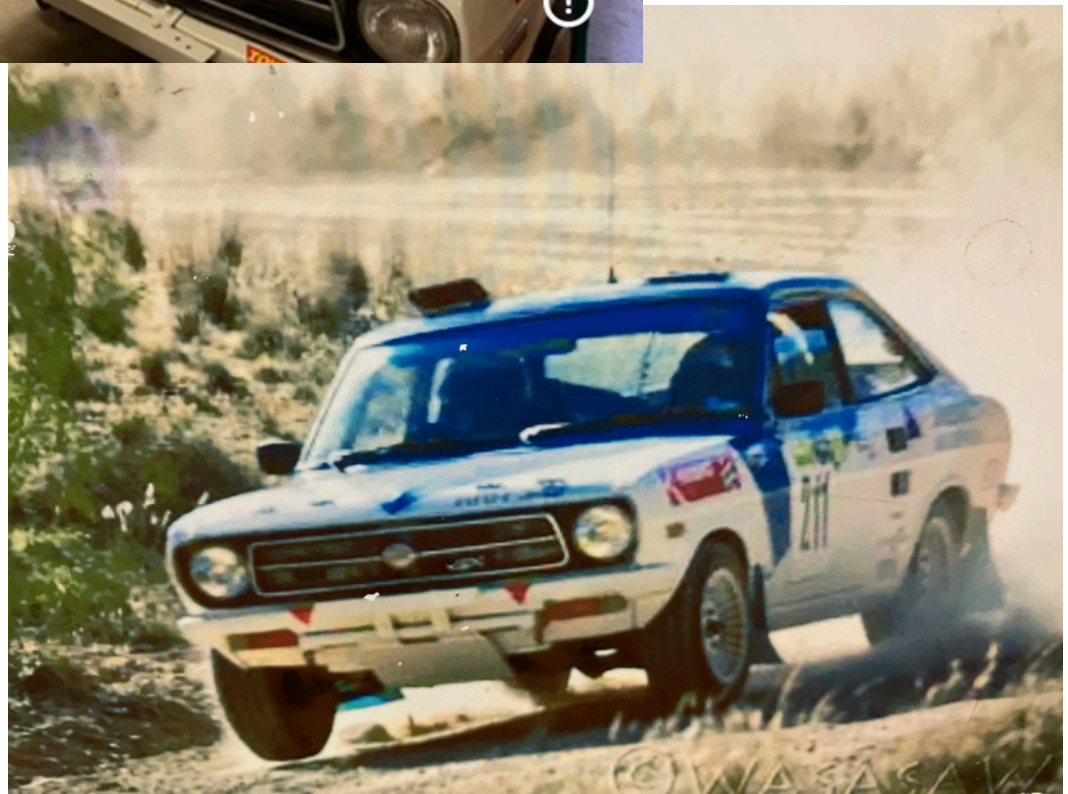

TRACK COMMITTEE

- We are still waiting to get the replacement tyre for the grader so that we can fit it, hopefully soon so that we can grade before our first event.
- The solar system is progressing. We have all the components for the system and Will Langdon is going to mount everything on a board so that it can be installed in one go, plus some cabling.
- We have started work to enclose the balcony. Please be aware that the existing railings are loose and no-one should go up on the balcony unless they are required to. We have taped off the access. Most of the new structural work is in place but it will be approx 8 weeks until the windows will arrive. The new viewing area is lower to enable larger windows so timing personnel can see Greta's Grotto and all the tracks while seated.
- The RSP shed is also progressing. We have received building approval from the council and are making a progress payment to start construction of the materials. That phase should be completed in July, and erection should take about 2 weeks to complete after that.
- Ben from Torrens Valley Mechanical is due at Walky Park next week to service all of our equipment.



RALLY SKILLS PROGRAM - 2026



- The committee decided to postpone Day 1 due to the ongoing war in the Middle East. We are planning to run Day 1 on Saturday, 16 May.
- Three of the coaches I lined up for Day 1 are now unavailable, so I need to start contacting everyone again to have a full complement for the rescheduled day 1.
- The cars need a little TLC before day 1 which is scheduled including a wash.
- At the moment we have 6 coaches confirmed for day 1.
- You don't need to do all days of the program, but if you can do some it gives us flexibility to fit in with peoples work and family commitments. If anyone else would like to help us, please contact me - It's also comforting for me if we have a reserve in case of last minute sickness or work.
- As previously advised we have 12 students committed for 2026 and now 14 names for 2027.
- I have contacted all of the students for this year again, with a view to them getting their MA licences, and to finalise payment of their fees.
- I will contact them all again in a few weeks just prior to day 1 of this year's program

RALLY SKILLS PROGRAM

Goals of Rally Skills Program

The Rally Skills Program's goals are to provide a safe space for young people and adults to learn and develop skills driving on gravel, with an emphasis on providing a gateway into Motorsport.

By developing a driver education program, we aim to educate drivers on the skills required to drive on gravel, as well as learn general driving skills. We will provide students an outlet to learn in a safe environment, being taught by experienced instructors in a family-friendly environment.

Students will use a supplied vehicle during the Program, to get experience and decide if they would like to pursue the sport, before having to outlay equipment and a vehicle, which can be a barrier to people participating.

The program aims to provide on ongoing support to assist students of the program to continue to develop skills and further their careers. We hope to start a buddy system where a participant can continue to be mentored by another club member to help them increase their skills and continue into the next level of Motorsport.

The program consists of 3 full day sessions/lessons with final event day when students get the opportunity to compete in a Walkerville All Cars Club Khanacross. The program will run once per year. A maximum of 12 students, split into two groups of 6.

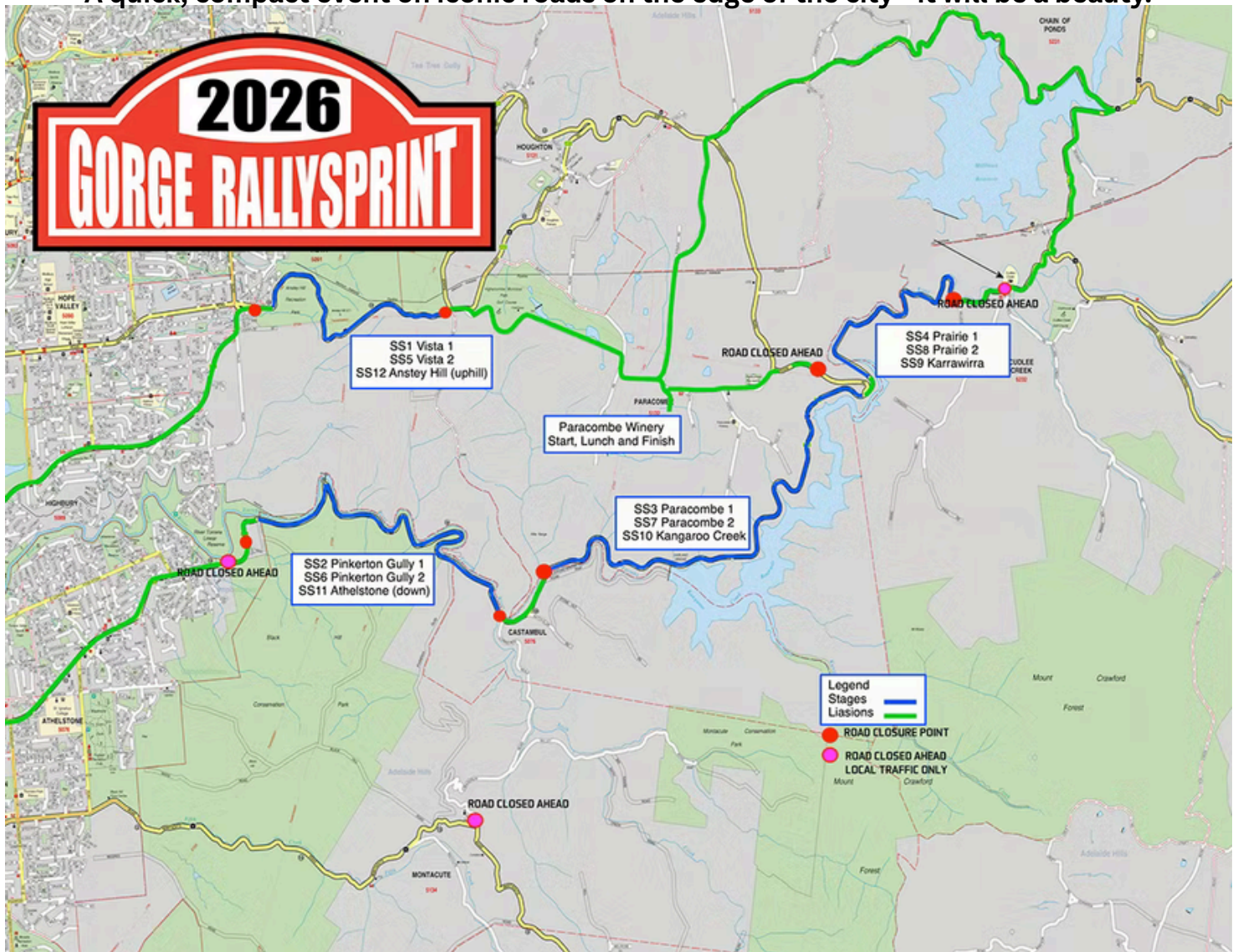
GORGE RALLYSPRINT

These are past their expiry dates and so not suitable for commercial use, but are still fit for purpose.

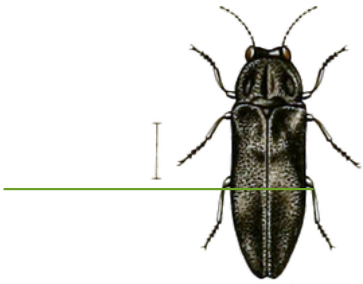
